## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Application for this scholarship is open to any student who meets the following criteria.

The legal child (natural or adoptive) of a disabled veteran of any branch of U.S. military service who is either a:

U.S. high school senior with a cumulative GPA of 3.0. or

U.S. student currently attending or enrolled in an accredited community college, undergraduate, or graduate degree program, with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.

A 500-word essay that answers one of the following:

How has your disabled veteran parent's experience inspired you in your education and career aspirations?

What advice would you give to a younger child growing up with a disabled veteran parent?

What do you believe is the single most important thing our society can do to help disabled veterans and their families?

A current transcript demonstrating your GPA of 3.5 or above (cumulative)

Applications must comply with all instructions as well as the Scholarship Terms & Conditions.

## WHAT IS THE DEADLINE TO APPLY?

The deadline to submit your application for the 2017 Child of a Disabled Veteran Scholarship is December 15, 2017.

The scholarship committee will review complete applications. We will notify the winner via e-mail or phone in early spring 2018.
